
- FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY. DO NOT USE THIS APPLIANCE FOR OTHER THAN ITS INTENDED USE.

GET TO KNOW YOUR TOASTER



- 1. Carriage Lever
- 2. Browning Display/Dial
- 3. Removable Crumb Tray
- 4. Feet (4)
- 5. Slots (2)
- 6. Housing
- 7. Bagel Button
- 8. Defrost Button
- 9. Reheat Button
- 10. Cancel Button

HOW TO OPERATE

Note: During the first use, it is normal to notice smoke and/or a slight odor.

TOASTING BREAD

- 1. Plug the toaster into an electrical outlet.
- 2. Insert the slice(s) into the slot(s) and select the desired browning level (1=lightest, 5=darkest).

Note: Fresh or coarse bread may require longer toasting (a darker browning level) than drier breads.

- 3. Push the carriage lever down until it locks into position.
- 4. When the toasting cycle is done, the toast will automatically pop up and the toaster will turn off.
- 5. Lift the carriage lever upward to safely remove the toast.
- 6. Unplug the power cord from the outlet.

TOASTING BAGELS

- 1. Plug the toaster into an electrical outlet.
- 2. Insert the bagel halves into the slot(s) and select the desired browning level.
- 3. Push the carriage lever down until it locks into position.
- 4. Press BAGEL. The toaster will lightly toast all sides of the bagel halves.
- 5. When the cycle is done, the bagel halves will automatically pop up and the toaster will turn off.
- 6. Lift the carriage lever upward to safely remove the bagel halves.
- 7. Unplug the power cord from the outlet.

TOASTING FROZEN BREAD

- 1. Plug the toaster into an electrical outlet.
- 2. Insert frozen bread (or waffles) into the slot(s) and select the desired browning level.
- 3. Push the carriage lever down until it locks into position.
- 4. Press DEFROST. The toaster will defrost, then toast the bread.
- 5. When the cycle is done, the toast (or waffles) will automatically pop up and the toaster will turn off.
- 6. Lift the carriage lever upward to safely remove the toast.
- 7. Unplug the power cord from the outlet.

HOW TO OPERATE

REHEATING TOAST

- 1. Plug the toaster into an electrical outlet.
- 2. Insert the cold toast into the slot(s) and select the desired browning level.
- 3. Push the carriage lever down until it locks into position.
- 4. Press REHEAT. The toaster will reheat the toast, but not overcook it.
- 5. When the cycle is done, the toast will automatically pop up and the toaster will turn off.
- 6. Lift the carriage lever upward to safely remove the toast.
- 7. Unplug the power cord from the outlet.

CANCEL

Press CANCEL at anytime to stop/interrupt any function.

CLEANING AND CARE

- 1. Turn off and unplug the appliance.
- 2. Allow the toaster to cool completely before cleaning.
- 3. DO NOT use abrasive pads or cleaners.
- 4. The outside surface of the toaster may be cleaned with a damp cloth. Dry with a soft cloth.
- 5. Empty the crumb tray at least once per week and wipe it with a soft cloth. DO NOT operate the toaster without the crumb tray in place.
- NEVER IMMERSE THE TOASTER, PLUG OR CORD INTO WATER OR ANY OTHER LIQUID.
